  - Background: High contrast color settings are available. **Only in the ePub format (and only if customer's ePub reading software supports it); not available in the PDF**
  - Text-to-speech tools. **Availability depends on reader's software.**
  - All images have alt tags. **This is true for the ePub format.**
  - All videos are captioned. **No videos present in the student text, but these are found in the Student Web Resource and they will be captioned by spring 2015.**
  - Text, image tags, and captioning sent to refreshable Braille displays. **Not provided. NOTE: In keeping with state requirements, we provide electronic files to NIMAC to allow Accessible Media Producers to create versions of student materials in alternative formats for schools as needed.**
2. How are the following **navigation features** provided in the instructional materials:
  - Non-text navigation elements (buttons, icons, etc.) can be adjusted in size. **Not provided.**
  - All navigation elements and menu items have keyboard shortcuts. **This depends on customer software.**
    - All navigation information can be sent to refreshable Braille displays. **Not provided. NOTE: In keeping with state requirements, we provide electronic files to NIMAC to allow Accessible Media Producers to create versions of student materials in alternative formats for schools as needed.**

  - Highlighters are provided in the four standard colors (yellow, rose, green, blue). **This depends on customer software.**
  - Highlighted text can be automatically extracted into another document. **This depends on customer software. The e-book does not have DRM, so we do not limit copying.**
  - Note taking tools are available for students to write ideas online; as they are processing curriculum content. **This depends on customer software.**
